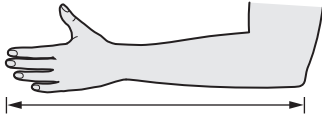

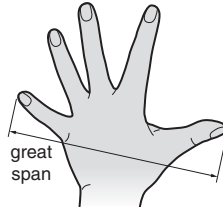
1. Use your body measures to find three objects that are about the size of each measurement below.
